



# Tennessee Professional Photographers Association Degree Program

Exceptional ability and service to professional photography and to this association shall be recognized by the awarding of degrees to individual members of this association.

# **Tennessee Certified Degree**

A total of 30 merits must be earned by a TNPPA member.

Of these 30 merits, a minimum of 16 must be print competition class A merits (not including Artisan/Master Artist merits as of 08/2019). The remaining can be print or achievement merits.

# **Tennessee Service Degree**

A total of 30 achievement merits must be earned by a TNPPA member. Of the 30 merits, a minimum of 16 must be class A achievement merits. The remaining merits may be class A or class B achievement merits. Print merits may not be used for this degree.

## **Tennessee Artisan Degree**

A total of 30 merits must be earned by a TNPPA member. Of these 30 merits, a minimum of 16 must be artisan print competition class A merits (not including Photographic Case merits earned). The remaining may be any A or B merit earned not used for another degree or bar.

### **Gold Bars**

After a member has received a degree, they may put each 25 additional merits earned towards a gold bar.

Degrees and Gold Bars will be issued at the annual awards banquet. You are responsible for submitting a request and any proof required of merits earned to the Certification Chair Person at least two months prior to the awards banquet. All merits must have also been earned by submission time.

Merit records are also your responsibility. Please have your chair person or officer sign off on any merits earned as soon as possible.

# **Record Keeping Instructions**

- 1. Put your name on your merit book.
- 2. You are responsible for keeping your own records. The officers are happy to help you, but it's your responsibility to record your merits and get your committee chair or officer to sign off on your merits.

- 3. Record book functions much like a check book, the last box of each line is for committee chair and board members to sign off.
- 4. We recommend that you keep a duplicate of your merit book. Scan it, photograph it, and copy it. Whatever works for you in case your merit book shall ever become lost.
  - 5. Make you entries at the time you earn your points so you get your merits.
- 6. All merits earned must be signed off by committee head or board member.
- 7. A copy of your merit book must be submitted with your degree or bar request to the Certification committee head.

Merits will only be issued if proper procedures are followed.

Any member found guilty of an infraction of the code of conduct or illegally entering a print in print competition will forfeit 5 merits after a hearing held by the current board.

When you are ready to earn your degree or bar, formally submit your request to the Certification Chair at least 2 months prior to the annual awards ceremony. Any degree earned after that will be awarded the following year.

The Board of Directors and Certification Chair Person will make any decisions on any conditions not mentioned unless over turned with a membership vote of 2/3 majority.
